Seven years and going strong!

On August 15, 2007 *A Baby's Breath* celebrated its seventh birthday. We opened seven years ago in a small office in Fairview Village. It has been a challenge to keep up with life's little and big changes, but through it all—our doors have been open.

In June, our landlord in St. David's presented us with a notice of a 25% increase in rent and he limited our signage. His actions forced us to look for a better location at the end of our lease. By the grace of God within two weeks of searching, we found an excellent location in Bryn Mawr right across the street from the movie theatre. We have excellent signage.

A group of Christian students volunteered to help us even before we knew we would be moving. They not only helped us move, they painted our new space and went around the neighborhood with an ad for our Run for Life—Main Line.

We have placed our ad for all three centers in three college directories reaching over 20,000 college-age students. The Jeffersonville center, which is our busiest center, had 65 clients last year. Our center was moved upstairs due to a flood last summer. We continued to see clients through the loss of a center and a director. We continued to grow and serve our clients with about twenty clients a month attending parenting classes. To manage the growth, we plan to transfer clients up to the Collegeville and Bryn Mawr centers to

accommodate the overflow. We are also seeking grant money to better facilitate our parenting classes.

Our Collegeville center continues to blossom with a new director, **Maryann McDonnell**, coming on board last year from St. Eleanor's parish. She is a woman of diminutive size, but with a huge heart that our clients embrace. One such client came to us with the need for many material things. We

We need to continue to stand by the mothers and fathers who have chosen life, but also to be a support for the mothers or fathers who have not chosen life. One of our volunteers who is post-abortive shares her story readily about how her daughter was not given her first breath. She torments about that decision every day. She told me that *A Baby's Breath* is where her daughter lives. Our mission to help a mother to see her child to take his/her first breath is validated by her testimony.
